2009:	"B.E.G. Burn, Earn, Gain" (Debt Free Living) Dean Troy Young, Instructor This course will focus on how we believers thoughtlessly fall into the burn segment of the "This Factor," simply put. We work had to earn our money, blessed to gain a bit from the government (Stimulus, Insurance, FEMA, ETC), And, to thoughtlessly burn it all on non- essentials.
2094	"A Christian View Toward Political Involvement " Dr. Murphy Simon, Instructor Impart a Christian view on politics from a biblical perspective in order to become familiar with the political process. Discuss the importance of the church as a strong foundation in assisting in the development of programs for the entire community.
2097	"Rethinking Christian Education" (Teacher Certification) Dr. Stanley T. Hillard, Instructor This class will examine the current trends, methodologies, & practices in Christian education to determine their validity & alliance with the Scriptures.
2100	"Guidelines for Recertification of Deans" Dean Ethel Stafford, Instructor This course instructs deans seeking recertification. Deans are required to be recertified every five (5) years. Contemporary issues in Christian education, trends, & methods will be addressed as a portion of this course.
8025	"Triage-Church Going AWOL (The Church's Response to Human Needs Through Community Action) Rev. Dwight Benoit, Instructor This course will make available information that will provide a strong support system for struggling parents and others working with children who have been affected by the pandemic.
8064	"Challenges of Being a Christian During the Pandemic" (The Challenge of Being Christian in America" Rev. Billy Ashley, Instructor This course will help students understand the facts about America and the pseudo-Christian values that fail much of the population. Challenge to strengthen the faith of the believers in Christ while working toward making a Christian difference in America during the post- pandemic period.
9908	"Tell the Story" (Narrative Preaching) Dr. Michael Rutledge, Instructor Remind the preacher that much preaching is simply "telling the story." This course points to many of the great stories of the Bible that serve to instruct our lives today. Much of the preaching of Jesus was done in narrative form.
9025	"Technology in a Post Pandemic World" (Computers in the Life of the Church 2) Rev. F. Ray Nelson, Instructor This course deals with equipping today's church to effectively develop a technology ministry & social media ministry. It will also address the security & ethical challenges that must be considered with policies & procedures.
